

Micro Labs launches new unit

■ **BANGALORE:** Bangalore-based pharma company Micro Labs has launched its new ophthalmology division, Micro Lumira. The new division will offer a wide range of ophthalmic medications across all therapeutic segments. With this addition, Micro Lab has 13 divisions in its portfolio including products in the anti-diabetes, antibiotics, antibacterials, cardiovascular and dermatology segments. The ophthalmic drugs will be manufactured at Micro Labs' eye drop facility in Bangalore, set up with an investment of Rs 70 crore. The facility has the capacity to produce two lakh bottles of ophthalmic preparations per day. Micro Labs already has a presence in the ophthalmology segment through its existing division Micro Vision. The company has 13 manufacturing facilities for oral solids, oral liquids, topicals and injectables in India and abroad.
